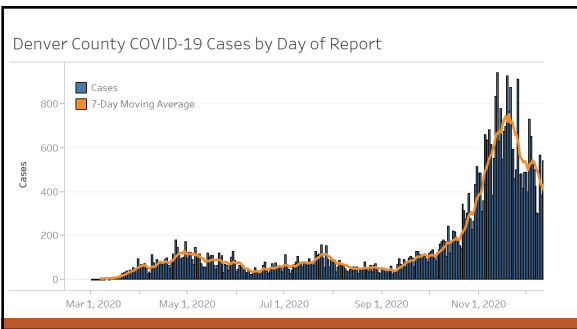

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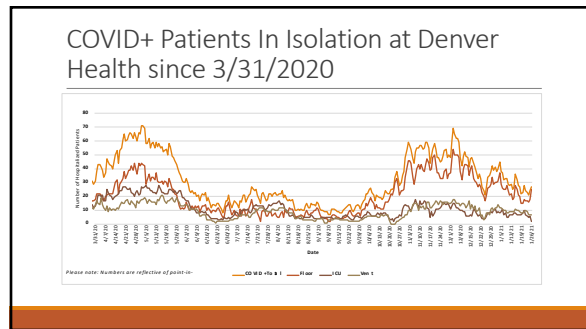

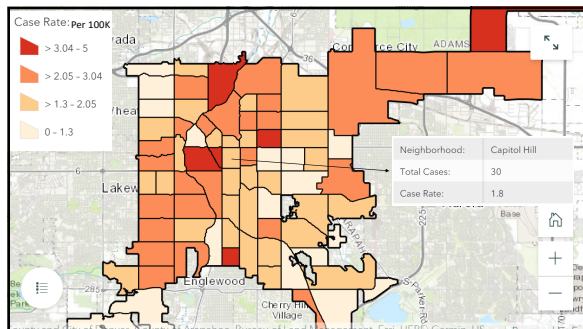
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Diagnostics: DH has capacity to run >1000 tests/day

Denver Health gets in-house coronavirus test, meaning results in 24 hours and safer frontline workers

First in house testing availability in the State

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Treatments with Proven or Potential Benefit Offered and Denver Health

- Remdesivir**- DH first non-VA site in Colorado to offer remdesivir; participated in NIH trial that showed drug allowed faster recovery for those hospitalized and needing oxygen
- Dexamethasone**- mortality benefit for patients who require oxygen; given routinely to COVID-19 patients who meet these criteria
- Convalescent plasma**- theoretical benefit but not yet proven; available to patients under emergency use authorization (EUA) by the FDA
- Bamlanivimab**- available to outpatients with mild to moderate COVID-19 who are at high risk for progression to severe disease under FDA EUA
- Other therapeutics** not listed may be available by clinical trial

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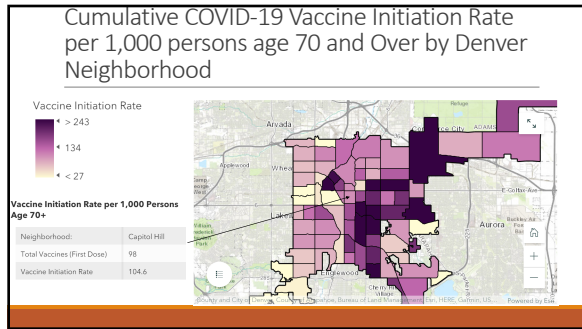

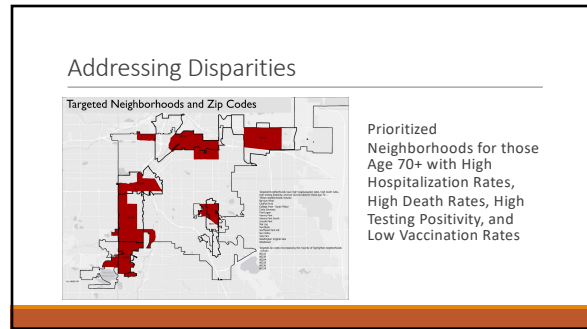

Note: CDPIH recognizes the Tribal sovereignty of the Ute Mountain Ute and Southern Ute Indian Tribes, and that the Tribes have the authority to determine how vaccine supply will be prioritized for their populations, even if their prioritization differs in alignment with what CDPIH recommends. Some health entities such as the Division of Public Health, Department of Defense, Department of State, Veterans' Hospital Association, and Indian Health Services will be vaccinated by the federal government. Children and pregnant people are not included in this preliminary phased approach; they may be prioritized for vaccine contemporaneously whenever safety and efficacy data are available with the appropriate ACIP recommendation.
