**CHUN CAPITOL HILL PEOPLE'S FAIR STREET CLOSURE INFORMATION:**

**Event dates: June 6 & 7, 2009**

Denver, Colo. – May 19, 2009 - The CHUN Capitol Hill People's Fair is one of the largest two-day festivals in the country with over 250,000 fairgoers, and is one of Colorado's longest running outdoor urban festivals featuring handmade arts & crafts, food from local restaurants and live local entertainment. This year the People's Fair is celebrating its 38th anniversary on June 6 & 7, 2009, from 10:00am-8:00pm on Saturday and 10:00am-7:00pm on Sunday in Denver's Civic Center Park located in Downtown Denver, Colorado. Admission is FREE!

The People's Fair will close the following streets for set-up and presentation of the event. Please refer to this list for specific street closure information including the date and time for each closure.

Thursday, June 4 – 7:00pm:	Bannock from Colfax Ave. to 14th Ave.
Friday, June 5 – 9:00am:	14th Ave. from Cherokee to Broadway Cheyenne Place from Broadway to Colfax Bannock from 13th Ave. to 14th Ave.
Friday, June 5 – 6:30pm:	14th Ave. from Broadway to Lincoln Colfax from Cherokee to Lincoln 14th Street from Court Place to Colfax 15th Street from Cleveland Place to Colfax
Friday, June 5 – 7:00pm:	Broadway (local traffic only) from 17th Ave. to 16th Ave. Broadway from 17th Ave. to 13th Ave.

The Denver Police will re-open all streets at approximately 3:00 am Monday, June 8, and meters will be unbagged at 9:00 am.

Parking for fairgoers is available for \$5.00 in the conveniently located **Cultural Facilities Parking Garage located on Broadway between 12th and 13th Avenues**. Parking is also available for \$10 in the **James Merrick State Parking Facility at 14th and Lincoln**. Other pay lots as well as metered parking is available within close proximity of the fairgrounds. Public transportation is available through RTD bus routes, Light Rail, 16th Street Mall Shuttle and Access-A-Ride. For more information visit [www.rtd-denver.com](http://www.rtd-denver.com). A bicycle corral will be located at the northeast corner of Lincoln Park (southwest corner of Colfax and Lincoln) where fairgoers may secure their bicycles for \$1.00, courtesy of Bike Denver. **In an effort to "Go Green" and work toward becoming an environmentally sustainable event, the People's Fair producers would like to encourage our attendees to take advantage of public transportation, ride your bicycle, or carpool to the People's Fair!**

Other important details and guidelines for fairgoers attending the 2009 People's Fair:

- No pets allowed - with the exception of service animals
- No alcohol, drugs or weapons
- No rollerblades, skateboards or bicycles in the fairgrounds
- All bags are subject to search at any time within boundaries of fairgrounds
- No picketing, soliciting or distributing of materials on fairgrounds
- Sale of items, services or food from other than a paid and approved People's Fair exhibitor is prohibited
