Major Event Definition & Scheduling

- I. What is "Major Event"
 - A. Currently 500+ expected attendance Level of Neighborhood Disruption at 500?
 - B. Would increase to 700 or 1000 be material?
- II. Limit Number of "Majors"
 - A. DBG realistic season: May 15 to Sep. 15 120 days and 17 weeks roughly
 - B. Is 10% or 12 appropriate, average roughly 2 each 3 weeks? Is 15% or 18, roughly 1 per week ok?
 - C. Negotiate reasonable maximum with DBG Max 2 per week?
- III. Pre-schedule all "Major" dates DBG
 - A. Even if events not booked
 - B. Produce parking signs to reflect possibility No enforcement (ticketing) if no event (Mile Hi model per art)
 - C. No last minute approvals needed
 - D. Schedule distribution by May 1 to neighborhoods Via NAC and outreach process
